

Clinical Mental Health Counseling—Admission Requirements

- All application materials must be submitted and reviewed prior to being scheduled for an interview with the Counselor Education Faculty. The **admission interview is the final step** in the application process.
- Required **application materials** include the following:
 - Undergraduate **transcripts** from degree-conferring institutions and **transcripts** for all graduate work. **Candidates who have completed an advanced degree or whose undergraduate GPA is 3.0 or above are NOT required to submit test scores.**
 - **Test score**—the Graduate Record Examination (GRE) or the Miller Analogies Test (MAT).
 - Applicants with less than a 3.0 GPA may be admitted based on the sliding scale in the table below.
 - Applicants who do not have the required GPA/Test scores in the table below, may be eligible for conditional admission with the following scores: 388/MAT or GRE 146/verbal and 140/quantitative.  - **Three Recommendation for Admission forms** completed by current/former supervisors or instructors. This form is available through the online application system.
 - **Resume**, including educational background, a record of employment and volunteer activities.
