A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- I. This Act shall be known and cited as the Executive Session Reformation Act
- II. The purpose of this bill is to amend current legislation within the SGA Code of Laws that currently contradicts the SGA Constitution and verify any future necessary disciplinary procedures following a violation of Executive Session.
- III. Chapter 500.1.5 of the Code of Laws currently reads:
All decisions made in Executive Session shall be made available to the public.
- IV. Chapter 500.1.5 now shall read:
All decisions made in Executive Session shall be kept strictly confidential and are to remain private. Discussion of any and all proceedings that occur within Executive Session, including conversing with other participants of the session, is prohibited and grounds for immediate dismissal upon the presentation of printed or digital evidence that verifies a violation and the approval by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the members present at Student Senate.
- V. This bill will become law upon ratification by two--thirds (2/3) vote of the University of North Alabama Student Government Association Senate and the subsequent approval of the Student Government Association President and Vice President.
