- I. This Act shall be known and cited as The Attendance Accountability Act.
- II. The purpose of this bill is to amend the Code of Laws Section 200.8.
- III. Section 200.8 currently reads:

“Tardiness to SGA meetings shall be grounds for dismissal from the SGA members’ respective branch. Three (3) tardies shall equal one (1) absence. Tardy shall be defined as entering the chambers after the last name is called during the Roll Call portion of the Agenda.”
- IV. Section 200.8 now shall read:

“Tardiness to and early departure from officially scheduled meetings of a member’s respective branch of the Student Government Association shall be grounds for dismissal from that branch.”

Section 200.8.1  
Three (3) tardies shall equal one (1) absence. A tardy shall be defined as entering the chambers after the last name is called during the Roll Call portion of the Agenda.

Section 200.8.2  
Three (3) early departures shall equal one (1) absence. An early departure shall be defined as leaving a meeting at any time after Roll Call has concluded and failing to return prior to the regular concluding time of Senate.

- V. This bill will become law upon ratification by two-thirds (2/3) vote of the University of North Alabama Student Government Association Senate and the subsequent approval of the Student Government Association President and Vice President.
