- She says she feels confident in herself by being fully transparent when she is communicating with other people.
- She says it is hard to be a transparent person when she can't say everything because of rules and laws that she has to follow.
- She says making decisions are tough, but the best way is to gather all the information needed before making a decision.
- She says the best way to avoid burnout is to be involved in different ways that are not tied into her main workload.
- She says she took the time and what she admires in other people and accepted the mistakes she has made and worked to avoid making the same mistakes.
